Please note DBS is an independent college and therefore fees apply. The fees for our undergraduate programmes for 2023/2024, are between €5,895 and €6,300 per annum.

The total fee includes all registration, tuition and examination costs. All our undergraduate courses have been approved for 20% tax relief.
