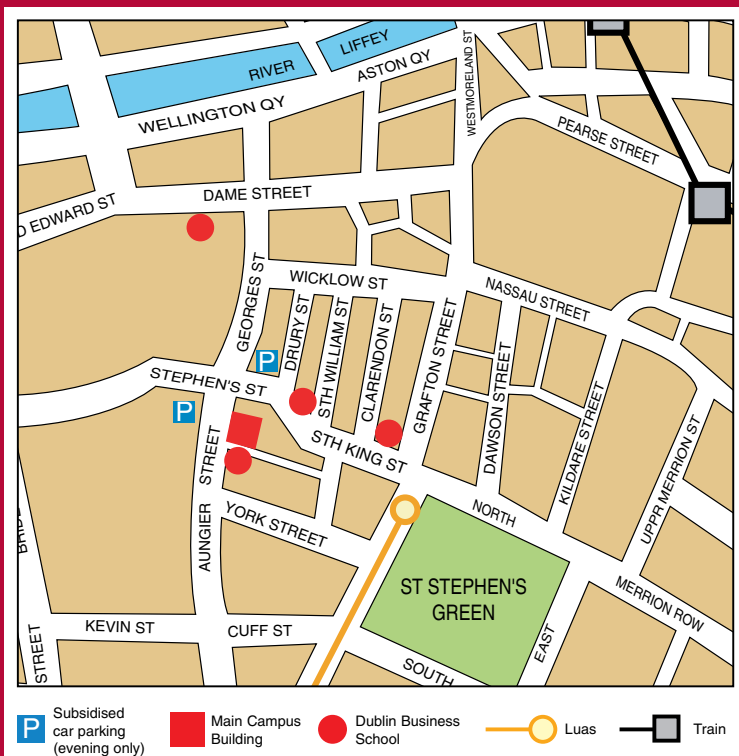
## **Oliver Costello, FCMA, MSc. (Mgmt), MBA, Barrister-at-Law, Paper Specialist: Law & Ethics**
