Please Note

1. Fees are calculated on the basis of how many modules are taken per annum. Students may opt to study a maximum of 45 credits (typically 4x10 credits, 1 x 5 credits) per annum. This is based on the learning route.
2. All undergraduate programmes of 2 years or more have been approved for tax relief purposes. Tax relief is granted to Irish resident taxpayers at the standard rate of income tax in respect of tuition fees paid exceeding €1,375 and up to €7,000 for part-time programmes only.
3. All programmes are run subject to numbers.
4. Fees stated above are for the academic year 2019/20 only.
5. Please note that fees are inclusive of tuition, registration, assessment and the protection of enrolled learners. It is expected that the fee for the protection of enrolled learners will increase in 2020.
